The Saints of the Week

Saint Lawrence (c. 225–258) was one of the seven deacons of Rome and served Pope Sixtus II during the persecution of Christians under the Emperor Valerian. As deacon, Lawrence was responsible for caring for the poor and distributing the Church's resources to those in need. When Roman authorities demanded that he surrender the treasures of the Church, Lawrence presented the poor, the sick, and the marginalized, declaring them the true treasures of the Church. For this bold witness, he was martyred on August 10, 258.

Saint Clare (1194–1253) was born into a noble family in Assisi, Italy. Inspired by the preaching and example of Saint Francis of Assisi, she left behind a life of privilege to dedicate herself completely to Christ. She founded the Order of Poor Ladies, later known as the Poor Clares, a community devoted to prayer, poverty, and service. Clare defended the spiritual poverty and independence of her community, even obtaining a special privilege from Pope Innocent IV to live according to the Gospel without possessions. Known for her deep Eucharistic devotion and holiness, she died on August 11, 1253, and was canonized just two years later.

Saint Maximilian Kolbe (1894–1941) was a Polish Franciscan priest, missionary, and founder of the Militia of the Immaculate, dedicated to spreading devotion to the Virgin Mary. A gifted writer and evangelizer, he used modern media to proclaim the Gospel. During World War II, he was imprisoned at Auschwitz. In 1941, he offered his life in exchange for another prisoner who had been condemned to die. After enduring two weeks of starvation, he was killed by lethal injection. Pope John Paul II canonized him in 1982 as a martyr of charity. His life remains a powerful witness to sacrificial love and faith in Christ.

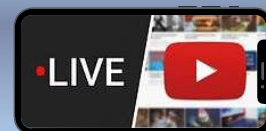
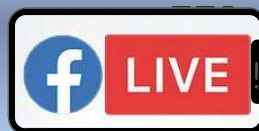

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The reading from the first Book of Kings recounts the prophet Elijah's encounter with God. Much to Elijah's surprise, God did not come to him in the wind or the earthquake, rather God came in a tiny whispering sound. In the Gospel, Jesus takes time apart to be quiet in God's presence, to listen to God. The storm which the disciples encounter was anything but and caused them to be frightened and uncertain about Jesus' presence. The scriptures today remind us that whether we are seeking some quiet prayer or facing a difficult or stormy situation - God is present desiring to relieve our fears and to give us hope. Be attentive then to the way God comes to you.

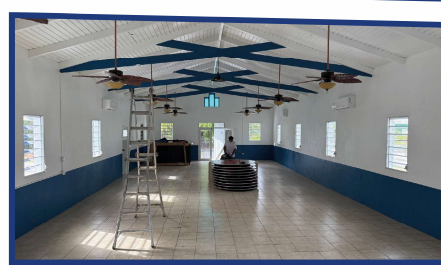
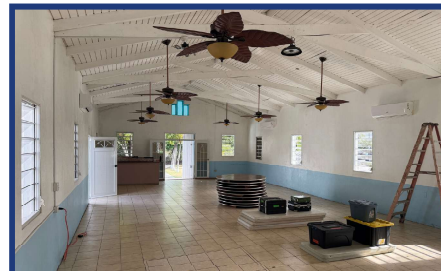

Catholic Questions — Answered —

Why do Catholics confess to a priest?

Catholics confess their sins to a priest because this is the way Christ chose to communicate His mercy after His Resurrection. On Easter evening Jesus breathed on the Apostles and said, "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (John 20:22–23). Through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Christ Himself forgives sins, while the priest acts in His person.

Every sin wounds our relationship with God and also harms the Church, the Body of Christ. Confession restores both. The priest not only grants absolution but also offers counsel, encouragement, and a penance to help us grow in holiness. Speaking our sins aloud also encourages humility, honesty, and sincere conversion.

Only God forgives sins, but He has chosen to exercise this ministry through the Church. Just as Christ used human hands to heal the sick, He now uses ordained ministers to bring His mercy to His people. Frequent confession helps us overcome sinful habits, strengthens our conscience, increases grace, and renews our friendship with God.

Far from being a source of fear, Confession is a personal encounter with the compassionate love of Jesus, who always welcomes back the repentant sinner and rejoices whenever one of His children returns home.

Para sorpresa de Elías, Dios no se manifestó en el viento impetuoso ni en el terremoto, sino en el suave susurro de una brisa. En el Evangelio, Jesús también se aparta para estar en silencio en la presencia de Dios y escuchar su voz. En contraste, la tormenta que enfrentan los discípulos en el lago les provoca miedo e incertidumbre, haciéndoles dudar de la presencia del Señor. Las Escrituras de hoy nos recuerdan que, ya sea cuando buscamos momentos de oración y silencio o cuando atravesamos dificultades y tormentas en la vida, Dios está siempre presente. Él desea calmar nuestros temores, fortalecer nuestra fe y llenarnos de esperanza. Preguntas Católicas Respondidas

¿Por qué los católicos se confiesan con un sacerdote?

Los católicos confesamos nuestros pecados a un sacerdote porque así quiso Jesucristo comunicar su misericordia después de su Resurrección. La tarde de Pascua sopló sobre los Apóstoles y les dijo: «A quienes les perdonen los pecados, les quedan perdonados» (Jn 20,22-23). En el Sacramento de la Reconciliación es Cristo mismo quien perdona; el sacerdote actúa en su nombre y con la autoridad que Él confió a la Iglesia.

Todo pecado hiere nuestra amistad con Dios y también daña a la Iglesia, que es el Cuerpo de Cristo. La confesión restaura ambas relaciones. Además de impartir la absolución, el sacerdote orienta al penitente, lo anima a cambiar de vida y le propone una penitencia que favorece su crecimiento espiritual. Expresar los pecados con sinceridad también fortalece la humildad y el verdadero arrepentimiento.

Solo Dios puede perdonar los pecados, pero Él ha querido servirse del ministerio de la Iglesia para comunicar ese perdón. Así como Cristo utilizó manos humanas para sanar a los enfermos, hoy utiliza a los sacerdotes para acercar su misericordia a quienes se arrepienten. La confesión frecuente fortalece la conciencia, ayuda a vencer el pecado habitual, aumenta la gracia y renueva nuestra amistad con Dios.

El confesionario no es un lugar de condena, sino el encuentro personal con el amor misericordioso de Cristo, que nunca se cansa de recibir al pecador que vuelve a Él.

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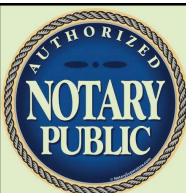
