# The Octave of Easter

The Octave of Easter is one of the most ancient and joyful celebrations in the Church's liturgical year. Rather than marking Easter as a single day, the Church **extends** the celebration over eight days, from Easter Sunday to Divine Mercy Sunday, treating each day as if it were Easter itself. This practice highlights the profound importance of the Resurrection, which is not just an event of the past but a reality that transforms all time.

The tradition of celebrating an "octave" dates back to the early centuries of Christianity. The number eight held symbolic meaning as the sign of a "new creation," going beyond the seven days of the original creation. In this sense, the Resurrection of Christ inaugurates a new world, one renewed by grace and freed from sin and death.

The Octave of Easter was also closely connected with the catechumens—those who had been preparing for baptism. In the early Church, baptisms were often celebrated during the Easter Vigil. The newly baptized, now called "neophytes," would wear white garments throughout the entire octave as a visible sign of their new life in Christ. These white vestments symbolized purity, rebirth, and their sharing in the light of the Resurrection. At the end of the octave, on the following Sunday, the neophytes would lay aside their white garments. For this reason, the day was historically known as *Dominica in albis* ("Sunday in white"). This marked the completion of their initiation and their full incorporation into the life of the Church.

Even today, the Octave of Easter invites all the faithful to enter more deeply into the joy of the Resurrection. Each day is celebrated with special solemnity, reminding us that Easter is not over in a moment but continues to shape our lives.

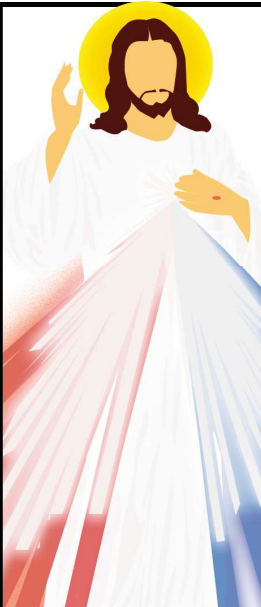

## Liturgical Corner

### The Liturgical Year: Walking with Christ

The liturgical year is the Church's way of guiding us through the mystery of Christ's life, death, and resurrection. Rather than following a calendar focused on secular events, the Church orders time around Christ and His saving work.

The year begins with Advent, a season of hope and preparation, followed by Christmas, celebrating the Incarnation. Lent invites repentance and conversion, leading to Easter, the greatest feast of the Church. The Easter season then extends this joy for fifty days, celebrating Christ's resurrection, His appearances to the disciples, and culminating in the Ascension and Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit is given to the Church. Ordinary Time helps us grow steadily in discipleship between these major seasons.

Living the liturgical year helps shape our spiritual lives. As we journey with Christ throughout the seasons, we are continually invited to deepen our faith, renew our commitment, and allow God's grace to transform us more fully.

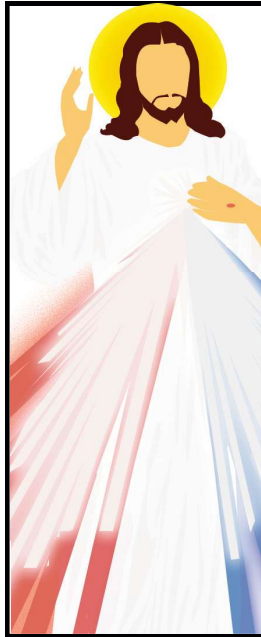

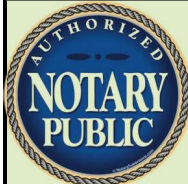
