

Saints of the Week

Saint Scholastica (c. 480–543) was the twin sister of Saint Benedict of Nursia and is considered the founder of women’s monasticism in the West. Living a life of prayer and consecration to God, she followed the spiritual principles that inspired the Benedictine Rule. Her deep holiness was shown through her intimate relationship with God, most famously when her prayer brought a sudden storm that kept Benedict with her in spiritual conversation. She is the patron saint of Benedictine nuns and of those seeking protection from storms.

Our Lady of Lourdes (Apparitions: 1858) refers to the Blessed Virgin Mary’s eighteen apparitions to Saint Bernadette Soubirous in Lourdes, France, in 1858. Mary appeared as the Immaculate Conception, calling for prayer, repentance, and trust in God’s mercy. Lourdes soon became one of the most important Marian pilgrimage sites in the world, renowned for its spring of water associated with miraculous healings. The devotion emphasizes humility, conversion, and compassion for the sick.

Saint Cyril (c. 827–869) and **Saint Methodius** (c. 815–885) were brothers from Thessalonica who became missionaries to the Slavic peoples of Great Moravia. Cyril created the Glagolitic alphabet, laying the foundation for Slavic written language and later the Cyrillic script. Together, they translated Scripture and liturgical texts into the Slavic tongue, allowing worship in the people’s own language. Honored as “Apostles to the Slavs,” they are co-patrons of Europe and champions of cultural and linguistic unity in the Church.

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)

The darkness of winter still surrounds us, making very relevant to our spiritual lives the theme of light and darkness in today’s readings. In the first reading, Isaiah reminds us that performing any work of mercy brings light into the darkness of our hearts and the world. Jesus, in speaking to the disciples and to us says, “You are the light of the world.... your light must shine before others. . .” As baptized children of God, we carry the light of Christ within us. It is important for us to reflect on whether our words and actions reflect the light of Christ. If they do not, what change will you make so that Christ’s light shines for others to see? By doing that, you have the power to diminish the darkness that exists around you!

From the Pastor's Pen



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This year is a grace-filled milestone as we celebrate the 80th anniversary of Saint Joseph Catholic Church. Apart from the Grand Anniversary Raffle and various Capital Improvements, this Anniversary challenges us to deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ, by turning in a special way to the one who knew Him, loved Him, and protected Him so faithfully: Saint Joseph.

For that reason, this weekend we will be gifting every parishioner a copy of the book *Consecration to Saint Joseph, The Wonders of our Spiritual Father*, by Fr. Donald Calloway, MIC. This is not just a book to read and place on a shelf—it is an opportunity to walk together as a parish on a simple, powerful spiritual journey during Lent and into the feast of Saint Joseph.

The Consecration is beautifully approachable. It involves 33 days of short daily readings and prayers, taking only 3–5 minutes a day. In those few minutes, you will reflect on Saint Joseph's role in salvation history, his virtues, his quiet strength, and his profound closeness to Jesus and Mary. The 33-day journey will conclude on **March 19th**, the Solemnity of Saint Joseph, Husband of Mary, with a formal Act of Consecration. That day will be a beautiful spiritual high point for our anniversary year and a powerful moment of unity for our parish.

For those who wish to go a step further, I invite you to join us for weekly Lenten reflections each Friday, following the 5:00 pm Stations of the Cross. These gatherings will be a time to share insights, pray together, and reflect on what we have read and discovered during the week. You may participate whether you come every week or only when you are able.

Please know that even if you cannot attend the Friday gatherings, you are still fully invited to take part in the consecration. This journey can be lived personally, within your family, or alongside friends—right where you are, at home.

My prayer is that, during this anniversary year, Saint Joseph's will not only celebrate 80 years of history, but will also be renewed in faith, hope, and love.

May Saint Joseph teach us how to listen to God, act with courage, and walk humbly with Christ. Let us grow closer to Jesus—through Joseph.

Liturgical Corner

The Mass: Source and Summit of Christian Life

The Second Vatican Council describes the Eucharist as the “source and summit of the Christian life,” a phrase that captures the central place of the Mass in the life of the Church. The Mass is the source because it nourishes us with God’s Word and the Body and Blood of Christ. From this sacred encounter flows the grace that strengthens us to live as faithful disciples in the world.

The Mass is also the summit because everything the Church does ultimately leads back to the Eucharist. Our prayers, works of charity, acts of justice, and personal sacrifices find their fullest meaning when united to Christ’s perfect offering on the altar. In the Mass, Christ offers Himself completely to the Father, and we are invited to offer our lives, joys, struggles, and sufferings along with Him.

This is why participation at Mass is essential, not optional, for Catholics. The Mass is not one devotion among many; it is the heart of Catholic life. When we participate fully, consciously, and actively—listening, responding, singing, and praying—we encounter Christ who teaches, feeds, and sends us forth. The Eucharist shapes our identity and strengthens us for our mission as the Church in the world.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Este año marca un hito de gracia al celebrar el 80.º aniversario de la Iglesia Católica de San José. Además de la Gran Rifa del Aniversario y las mejoras importantes, este aniversario nos invita a profundizar nuestra relación con Jesucristo, recurriendo de manera especial a quien lo conoció, lo amó y lo protegió con tanta fidelidad: San José.

La Misa: Fuente y Culmen de la Vida Cristiana

El Concilio Vaticano II describe la Eucaristía como “fuente y culmen de la vida cristiana”, una frase que capta el lugar central de la Misa en la vida de la Iglesia. La Misa es la fuente porque nos nutre con la Palabra de Dios y el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. De este encuentro sagrado fluye la gracia que nos fortalece para vivir como discípulos fieles en el mundo.

La Misa es también la culmen porque todo lo que la Iglesia hace, en última instancia, conduce de vuelta a la Eucaristía. Nuestras oraciones, obras de caridad, actos de justicia y sacrificios personales encuentran su pleno significado cuando se unen a la ofrenda perfecta de Cristo en el altar. En la Misa, Cristo se ofrece completamente al Padre, y estamos invitados a ofrecer nuestras vidas, alegrías, luchas y sufrimientos junto con Él.

Por eso, la participación en la Misa es esencial, no opcional, para los católicos. La Misa no es una devoción entre muchas; es el corazón de la vida católica. Cuando participamos plena, consciente y activamente —escuchando, respondiendo, cantando y orando—, encontramos a Cristo que nos enseña, nos alimenta y nos envía. La Eucaristía moldea nuestra identidad y nos fortalece para nuestra misión como Iglesia en el mundo.






