*The Saints of the Week*

**Saint Peter Chanel** (12 July 1803 – 28 April 1841). A Marist missionary priest, Peter Chanel evangelized Futuna in the South Pacific. Known for patience and gentleness, he persevered amid hostility from local leaders. His growing influence led to his martyrdom. After his death, the island converted to Christianity, making him a powerful witness to steadfast faith and sacrificial love.

**Saint Catherine of Siena** (25 March 1347 – 29 April 1380). A Dominican tertiary and mystic, Catherine of Siena dedicated her life to prayer, penance, and service. She advised popes and worked tirelessly for Church unity, helping return the papacy from Avignon to Rome. Renowned for her spiritual writings and profound holiness, she was later declared a Doctor of the Church.

**Saint Joseph the Worker** (c. 1st century BC – c. 1st century AD). Honored under the title “the Worker,” Joseph exemplifies dignity in labor and faithful obedience. A humble carpenter, he provided for the Holy Family and protected Mary and Jesus. Though little is recorded about him, his quiet righteousness and trust in God make him a model for workers and family life.

**Saint Athanasius** (c. 296 – 2 May 373). A bishop and theologian, Athanasius defended the divinity of Christ against Arianism. Despite exile and persecution, he remained steadfast in upholding orthodox doctrine. His writings, especially on the Incarnation, shaped Christian theology. Revered as a Doctor of the Church, he is remembered for courage, clarity, and unwavering commitment to truth.

## Liturgical Corner

### Sacred Music in the Liturgy

Music holds a privileged place in the Church's liturgy because it unites prayer and praise. Sacred music is not meant to entertain or perform but to support and elevate the prayer of the assembled faithful. When music is truly liturgical, it draws attention not to itself but to the mystery being celebrated.

Through hymns, psalms, and acclamations, music helps the congregation participate more fully in the Mass. Singing together expresses unity and allows the Word of God to dwell more deeply in our hearts. Certain parts of the Mass, such as the Responsorial Psalm and Gospel Acclamation, are especially meant to be sung.

The Church encourages music that reflects the sacred nature of the liturgy and is appropriate to the season and rite. By approaching sacred music as prayer rather than performance, both musicians and congregation help create an atmosphere of reverence that lifts hearts and minds to God.

### Música Sagrada en la Liturgia

La música ocupa un lugar privilegiado en la liturgia de la Iglesia porque une la oración y la alabanza. La música sagrada no está destinada a entretener ni a ser una actuación, sino a sostener y elevar la oración de los fieles reunidos. Cuando la música es verdaderamente litúrgica, no atrae la atención hacia sí misma, sino hacia el misterio que se celebra.

A través de himnos, salmos y aclamaciones, la música ayuda a la asamblea a participar más plenamente en la Misa. Cantar juntos expresa la unidad y permite que la Palabra de Dios habite más profundamente en nuestros corazones. Algunas partes de la Misa, como el Salmo Responsorial y la Aclamación al Evangelio, están especialmente destinadas a ser cantadas.

La Iglesia fomenta una música que refleje la naturaleza sagrada de la liturgia y que sea apropiada al tiempo litúrgico y al rito. Al vivir la música sagrada como oración y no como espectáculo, tanto los músicos como la asamblea contribuyen a crear un ambiente de reverencia que eleva los corazones y las mentes hacia Dios.

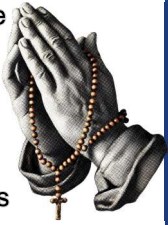

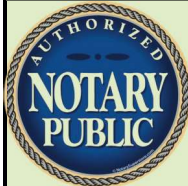
