The Saints of the Week

Pope John I (c. 470–526) was pope from 523 until his death and is honored as a martyr. Born in Tuscany, he led the Church during tensions between the Ostrogothic king Theodoric and the Byzantine Empire. Sent to Constantinople to negotiate religious disputes, he succeeded diplomatically but was later accused of treason by Theodoric. Imprisoned in Ravenna, he died from harsh treatment and starvation, remaining faithful to the Church until the end.

Saint Bernadine of Siena (1380–1444) was a Franciscan friar renowned for preaching repentance and devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus. After caring for plague victims in his youth, he traveled throughout Italy calling people to peace and moral reform. He popularized the “IHS” symbol representing Jesus’ name and helped renew the Franciscan Order through his holiness and eloquence.

Saint Rita of Cascia (1381–1457) is the patron saint of impossible causes. After enduring a difficult marriage and losing her husband and sons, she entered an Augustinian convent. Known for prayer, charity, and forgiveness, Rita experienced mystical visions and became a symbol of hope and perseverance in suffering.

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

This week, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, our readings make very clear our commission as disciples of Jesus Christ. Consider the final words of the Master, “Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature.” Jesus does not depart to leave us alone; He ascends to His throne so that He might fill the entire universe with His presence. Bring the hope of the Ascended Lord into every aspect of your daily life: in your household chores and your professional duties, in your public interactions and your private prayers. By doing so, you become a living bridge between Heaven and Earth, passing along the promise of eternal life to your children, your colleagues, or a stranger seeking purpose.

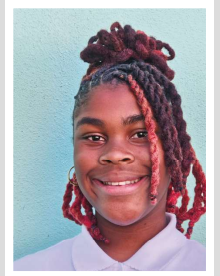

Liturgical Corner

Vestments: Clothing for Sacred Service

Liturgical vestments are worn by priests and deacons not for personal distinction, but to signify their sacred role in the liturgy. Vestments help the minister step aside so that Christ may be more clearly seen acting through the Church.

Each vestment carries symbolic meaning. The alb represents purity of heart, the stole signifies ordained ministry, and the chasuble represents charity. By wearing vestments, the priest serves not as a private individual but as a minister of Christ and the Church.

Vestments also connect the present celebration to centuries of tradition. They remind us that the liturgy is timeless and universal, uniting us with Catholics throughout history in the worship of God.

Rincón Litúrgico

Vestiduras: Vestimenta para el Servicio Sagrado

Las vestiduras litúrgicas son usadas por sacerdotes y diáconos no para distinción personal, sino para significar su papel sagrado en la liturgia. Estas prendas ayudan al ministro a desaparecer en cierto sentido, para que Cristo pueda ser visto con mayor claridad actuando a través de la Iglesia.

Cada vestidura posee un significado simbólico. El alba representa la pureza del corazón, la estola significa el ministerio ordenado y la casulla representa la caridad. Al vestirlas, el sacerdote no actúa como un individuo privado, sino como ministro de Cristo y de la Iglesia. Las vestiduras también conectan la celebración actual con siglos de tradición. Nos recuerdan que la liturgia es atemporal y universal, uniendo a los católicos de todas las épocas en la adoración de Dios.

PRAYER AFTER HURRICANE SEASON

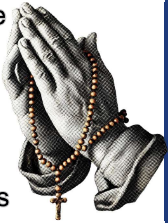

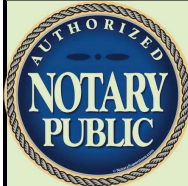

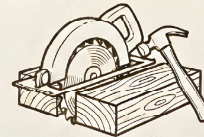
