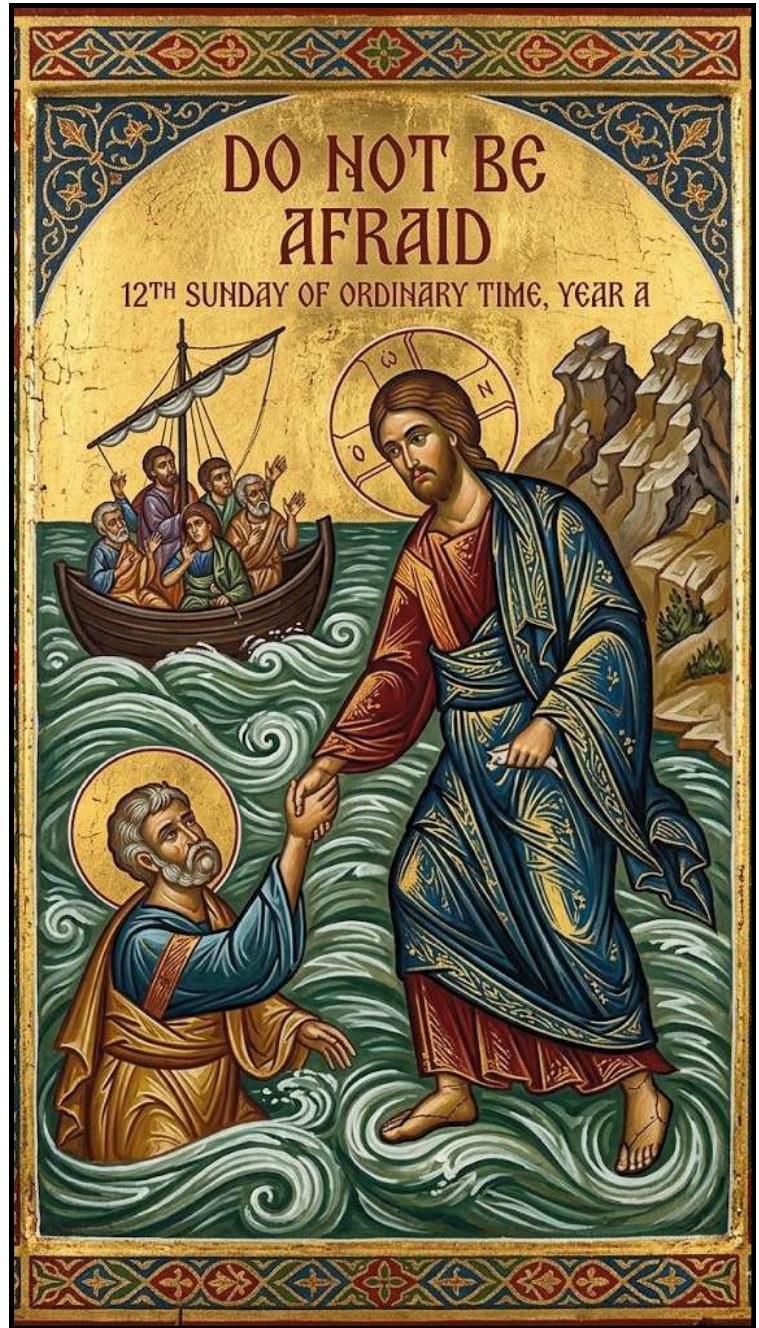

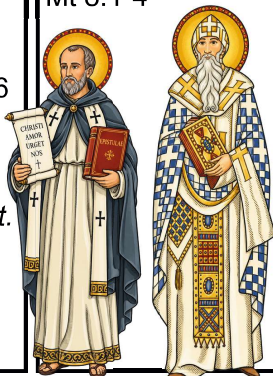

The Saints of the Week

St. Paulinus of Nola (c. 354–431) – Born in Bordeaux, Gaul, Paulinus came from a wealthy Roman family and received an excellent education. After a successful political career, the death of his son led him to embrace a life of Christian devotion. Together with his wife, Therasia, he gave away much of his wealth to aid the poor. Ordained a priest in 394 and later Bishop of Nola, he became known for his charity, humility, and spiritual writings. He promoted devotion to St. Felix of Nola and helped make Nola a major pilgrimage center. He died in 431.

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist (Birth: c. 6–5 BC; Death: c. AD 28–30) – The Nativity of St. John the Baptist celebrates the miraculous birth of the precursor of Christ. Born to the elderly Zechariah and Elizabeth, John’s birth was announced by the Archangel Gabriel. His arrival fulfilled God’s promise and restored Zechariah’s speech after he named the child John. Filled with the Holy Spirit, John later preached repentance and baptized Jesus in the Jordan River, preparing the people for the coming of the Messiah.

St. Cyril of Alexandria (c. 376–444) – Born in Egypt, Cyril became Patriarch of Alexandria in 412. He was one of the Church’s greatest theologians and defenders of orthodox Christian teaching. Cyril led the opposition to Nestorius and played a central role at the Council of Ephesus in 431, where the title Theotokos (“Mother of God”) was affirmed for the Virgin Mary. His writings greatly influenced Christian doctrine. He died in 444 and was later declared a Doctor of the Church.

Our readings today speak of God’s care and providence. Three times in the gospel we are reminded not to be afraid. Some days we need to hear that message repeatedly. It was not only the first disciples, but it is true for us as well to be reminded – that being a disciple of Christ requires a certain amount of courage and fearlessness. Let us set aside our fear and hold fast to the message Jesus speaks about God’s love and providence, remembering that nothing can separate us from the love of God that has been poured out for us in Christ Jesus!

Liturgical Corner

The Tabernacle and Eucharistic Reservation

The tabernacle is the sacred place where the Eucharist is reserved after Mass. Its primary purpose is to allow Communion to be brought to the sick and homebound, and to provide a place for prayer and adoration of Christ present in the Blessed Sacrament. Because the Eucharist is truly Christ Himself, the tabernacle holds a place of honor in the church.

A lamp burns continuously near the tabernacle, reminding us of Christ's abiding presence. Catholics show reverence by genuflecting or bowing deeply toward the tabernacle, acknowledging the Lord who remains with His people. This simple gesture expresses faith in the Real Presence and cultivates a spirit of devotion.

Eucharistic reservation reminds us that Christ's presence extends beyond the celebration of Mass. Whether we come for a brief visit or extended prayer, time spent before the tabernacle deepens our relationship with Jesus and strengthens us for Christian living.

El Tabernaculo y la Reserva Eucarística

El tabernaculo es el lugar sagrado donde se reserva la Eucaristía después de la Misa. Su propósito principal es permitir que la Sagrada Comunión sea llevada a los enfermos y a quienes no pueden asistir a la iglesia, así como proporcionar un lugar para la oración y la adoración de Cristo presente en el Santísimo Sacramento. Debido a que la Eucaristía es verdaderamente Cristo mismo, el tabernaculo ocupa un lugar de honor dentro del templo.

Una lámpara permanece encendida continuamente cerca del tabernaculo, recordándonos la presencia permanente de Cristo. Los católicos muestran reverencia haciendo una genuflexión o una profunda inclinación hacia el tabernaculo, reconociendo al Señor que permanece con su pueblo. Este sencillo gesto expresa la fe en la Presencia Real y fomenta un espíritu de devoción.

La reserva eucarística nos recuerda que la presencia de Cristo se extiende más allá de la celebración de la Misa. Ya sea que acudamos para una breve visita o para un tiempo prolongado de oración, el tiempo pasado ante el tabernaculo profundiza nuestra relación con Jesús y nos fortalece para vivir la vida cristiana.

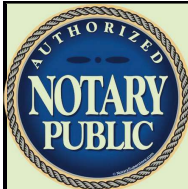
