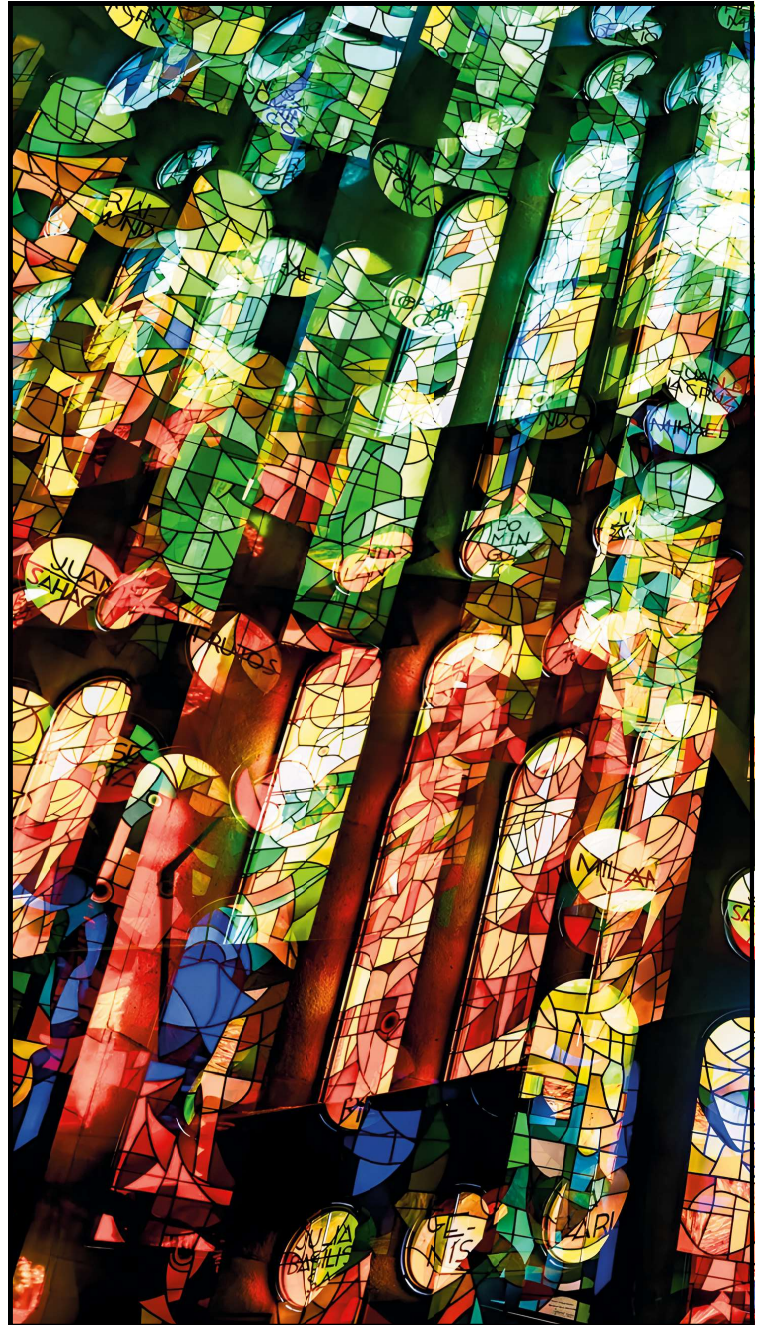

NOVEMBER 16 ~ THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

As this Liturgical Year draws to a close the Church invites us to reflect on the relevance of the gospel to our daily lives. Jesus wants us to realize that this world and all its goods are fleeting. However, our perseverance in faith, right up to the end of our lives is what really matters. Faith guides our responses when we are faced with disasters, hardships and polarization all of which are so prevalent in our world. Remaining steadfast as people of faith, attentive to the word of God and persevering in our discipleship, is always the best course to follow.
