The Saints of the Week

Mary, Martha, Lazarus – Mary is remembered in the Gospels for her deep love and devotion to the Lord. While Martha served, Mary sat at the feet of Jesus, listening to His teaching and choosing “the better part” (Lk 10:42). Martha welcomed Jesus into her home. She is known for her hospitality and service, but also for her profound profession of faith when Lazarus died: “I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God” (Jn 11:27). Lazarus was raised from the dead by Jesus, revealing Christ’s power over sin and death. His resurrection became a sign pointing toward Jesus’ own victory over the grave.

Saint Ignatius of Loyola (1491–1556) was the founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). He was a Spanish soldier who experienced a profound conversion after being wounded in battle. Through prayer and spiritual discernment, he dedicated his life to serving God and helping others grow in faith. His Spiritual Exercises continue to guide people in prayer and discernment.

Saint Alphonsus Liguori (1696–1787) was an Italian bishop, theologian, and founder of the Redemptorists. Alphonsus dedicated his life to preaching, moral theology, and serving the poor. He was known for his compassion toward sinners and his devotion to the Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin Mary. He is honored as a Doctor of the Church for his contributions to theology and pastoral care.

JULY 26

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In our first reading we hear that God was pleased with Solomon’s request for an understanding heart! Take note, Solomon does not ask for riches or a long life or even an untroubled life. His request may give us pause to consider what we put values on, what priorities we have, and think is important. Would our answer be like that of Solomon? To help us be clearer about what is important, Jesus gives us two additional short parables: the pearl of great price and the hidden treasure. Do we consider our faith as a pearl of great price, or a treasure to seek? These readings give us much food for thought and prayer – about what we value, what we pursue, and whose we want to be!

Active participation is a key principle of the Church's teaching on the liturgy. It involves more than external actions; it includes attentive listening, interior prayer, and intentional engagement. Through responses, singing, posture, and silence, the faithful join fully in the liturgical action. True participation allows the liturgy to shape our hearts and lives, helping us to encounter Christ more deeply and to unite ourselves with the prayer of the whole Church.

When we participate actively, the liturgy forms us as disciples and sends us forth to live what we celebrate in the world. It calls us to move beyond simply being present and to become conscious participants in the mystery of faith. Through the grace received in the liturgy, our minds are enlightened, our hearts are renewed, and our lives are transformed so that we may reflect Christ's love and mercy in our daily actions. The liturgy nourishes us to become witnesses of the Gospel, carrying the fruits of our worship into our families, communities, and the world around us.

26 DE JULIO DECIMOSÉPTIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

En la primera lectura escuchamos que Dios se complació con la petición de Salomón de recibir un corazón comprensivo. Notemos que Salomón no pidió riquezas, una vida larga ni tampoco una vida sin dificultades. Su petición nos invita a reflexionar sobre aquello que valoramos, nuestras prioridades y lo que realmente consideramos importante.

¿Sería nuestra respuesta semejante a la de Salomón?

Para ayudarnos a comprender mejor lo que tiene verdadero valor, Jesús nos presenta dos parábolas breves: la perla de gran valor y el tesoro escondido.

¿Consideramos nuestra fe como una perla preciosa o como un tesoro que debemos buscar con todo nuestro corazón?

Estas lecturas nos ofrecen mucho para reflexionar y orar: sobre lo que valoramos, aquello que buscamos y a quién queremos pertenecer. Que podamos reconocer el verdadero tesoro de nuestra vida en Cristo y elegir siempre caminar según su voluntad.

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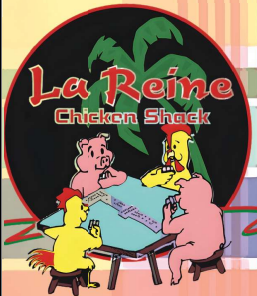
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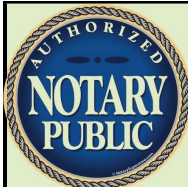
