Saints of the Week

The Seven Founders of the Servite Order were seven wealthy Florentine merchants who, in the early 13th century, felt called to leave their comfortable lives to dedicate themselves entirely to God. Around 1233, in Florence, they withdrew from society to live a life of prayer, penance, and communal poverty, placing themselves under the special patronage of the Virgin Mary. Eventually settling on Mount Senario near Florence, they embraced a contemplative life centered on devotion to Mary—especially her sorrows—while also serving the spiritual needs of others. Their way of life attracted followers, and what began as a small brotherhood grew into the Order of Servants of Mary. The Church officially recognized the order later in the 13th century. The Seven Founders are remembered not as scholars or preachers at first, but as ordinary laymen whose radical choice for humility, unity, and Marian devotion shaped a religious order that continues today.

Jesus makes clear in today's gospel, "whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be called least in the kingdom of heaven." Do you hear them express your patience or impatience, your compassion or your intolerance, your anger or your calmness? Ask Christ for the grace to set a good example to those in your life. Your choices will lead to everlasting life!




33-DAY CONSECRATION TO SAINT JOSEPH

Liturgical Corner

The Structure of the Mass

The Mass follows a clear and intentional structure that guides us into deeper communion with God. It is divided into four main parts: the Introductory Rites, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and the Concluding Rites. Each part has a specific purpose, yet all together form one unified act of worship.

The Introductory Rites gather the faithful, establish unity, and prepare our hearts for prayer.

The Liturgy of the Word allows God to speak to us through Sacred Scripture, calling us to faith and conversion.

In the Liturgy of the Eucharist, bread and wine are offered, consecrated, and received as the Body and Blood of Christ.

Finally, the Concluding Rites send us forth to live out the mystery we have celebrated.

This structure is deeply rooted in the Church's tradition and reflects how God forms His people: He gathers them, speaks to them, feeds them, and sends them on mission. Understanding the flow of the Mass helps us participate more intentionally and appreciate how each part prepares us for the next, drawing us ever deeper into the mystery of Christ.

La Estructura de la Misa

La Misa sigue una estructura clara e intencionada que nos guía hacia una comunión más profunda con Dios. Se divide en cuatro partes principales: los Ritos Iniciales, la Liturgia de la Palabra, la Liturgia Eucarística y los Ritos Conclusivos. Cada parte tiene un propósito específico, pero todas juntas forman un acto de culto unificado.

Los Ritos Iniciales reúnen a los fieles, establecen la unidad y preparan nuestros corazones para la oración.

La Liturgia de la Palabra permite que Dios nos hable a través de la Sagrada Escritura, llamándonos a la fe y a la conversión.

En la Liturgia Eucarística, el pan y el vino se ofrecen, se consagran y se reciben como el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo.

Finalmente, los Ritos Conclusivos nos invitan a vivir el misterio que hemos celebrado.

Esta estructura está profundamente arraigada en la tradición de la Iglesia y refleja cómo Dios forma a su pueblo: lo reúne, le habla, lo alimenta y lo envía en misión. Comprender el ritmo de la Misa nos ayuda a participar con mayor intensidad y a apreciar cómo cada parte nos prepara para la siguiente, adentrándonos cada vez más en el misterio de Cristo.




