

Saints of the Week

Saint Katharine Drexel (November 26, 1858 – March 3, 1955) was born into a wealthy Philadelphia family but chose a life of religious service. Deeply moved by the plight of Native Americans and African Americans, she founded the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament, dedicating her fortune to establishing schools and missions across the United States. Her work promoted racial justice and Catholic education during a time of widespread discrimination. She was canonized in 2000 for her lifelong commitment to charity and equality.

Saint Casimir (October 3, 1458 – March 4, 1484) was a prince of Poland and Lithuania known for his piety, humility, and devotion to the poor. Though heir to the throne, he lived simply, practiced chastity, and spent long hours in prayer. He refused political power that conflicted with his conscience and became a model of Christian virtue for both royalty and youth. He is the patron saint of Poland and Lithuania.

Saint Perpetua (c. 181 – March 7, 203) and **Saint Felicity** (c. 183 – March 7, 203) were early Christian martyrs in Carthage. Perpetua, a young noblewoman and mother, and Felicity, her servant who was pregnant at the time of arrest, were imprisoned for refusing to renounce their faith. After enduring trials and witnessing visions that strengthened them, they were executed in the arena. Their courage and steadfast faith made them powerful witnesses in the early Church.

From the Pastor's Pen

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We are already in the second week of Lent and halfway through our preparation for our Parish-wide Consecration to Saint Joseph, our Patron Saint. I hope these 33 days have been as enriching for you as they have been for me. The more I pray the Litany of St. Joseph, the more I realize how little we know about this great Saint.

One title especially caught my attention: *Terror of Demons*. Why would St. Joseph be called this? Scripture records no dramatic words or miracles from him. Yet his power lies precisely in his quiet strength.

In her Diary, Saint Faustina Kowalska recounts terrifying encounters with evil spirits, especially when praying for dying souls. When she began to pray, the demons fled. Even she experienced moments of fear, and Jesus reminded her not to give in to "vain terrors," but to trust completely in Him.

St. Faustina later wrote that St. Joseph urged her to have constant devotion to him and promised her special help and protection. The Church calls him *Terror of Demons* because of who he is: the guardian of the Redeemer, the chaste spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the protector of the Holy Family. His humility, obedience, and unwavering trust in God are intolerable to the forces of darkness. Evil thrives on fear and despair. St. Joseph stands firm in faith and confidence in God's providence. He protected Jesus and Mary on earth; from Heaven he continues to protect the Church and our families.

As we continue our Lenten journey, let us turn to him in moments of anxiety and trial. May he strengthen our trust and guard us from every evil.

St. Joseph, Terror of Demons, pray for us!

Liturgical Corner

The Liturgy of the Word: God Speaks to His People

In the Liturgy of the Word, God addresses His people through the inspired words of Sacred Scripture. The readings follow a carefully arranged lectionary that ensures the faithful hear a wide and balanced selection of the Bible over time. Through these readings, Christ is truly present, speaking to His Church today.

Typically, the Liturgy of the Word includes a reading from the Old Testament, a Responsorial Psalm, a New Testament reading, and the Gospel. The Gospel holds a place of special reverence because it proclaims the words and actions of Christ Himself. The homily helps explain and apply the readings, connecting God's Word to our daily lives.

Our responses—the Psalm, the Gospel Acclamation, the Profession of Faith, and the Prayer of the Faithful—are essential expressions of active participation.

By listening attentively and responding prayerfully, we allow God's Word to shape our minds, deepen our faith, and call us to ongoing conversion.

Desde la pluma del parroco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Ya estamos en la segunda semana de Cuaresma y a mitad de nuestro camino de preparación para la Consagración Parroquial a San José, nuestro Santo Patrono. Espero que estos 33 días estén siendo tan enriquecedores para ustedes como lo han sido para mí. Cuanto más rezo las Letanias de San José, más me doy cuenta de lo poco que conocemos a este gran Santo.

Hay un título que llamó especialmente mi atención: *Terror de los Demonios*. ¿Por qué se le llama así? La Sagrada Escritura no recoge palabras espectaculares ni milagros realizados por él. Sin embargo, su poder reside precisamente en su fortaleza silenciosa.

En su Diario, Santa Faustina Kowalska relata encuentros aterradores con espíritus malignos, especialmente cuando oraba por los moribundos. Cuando comenzó a rezar, los demonios huyeron. Incluso ella experimentó momentos de temor, y Jesús le recordó que no cediera a "miedos vanos", sino que confiara plenamente en Él.

Más tarde, Santa Faustina escribió que San José le pidió tener una devoción constante hacia él y le prometió ayuda y protección especial. La Iglesia lo llama *Terror de los Demonios* por quien es: custodio del Redentor, casto esposo de la Santísima Virgen María y protector de la Sagrada Familia. Su humildad, obediencia y confianza inquebrantable en Dios son insuperables para las fuerzas del mal. El mal se alimenta del miedo y la desesperación; San José permanece firme en la fe y en la confianza en la Providencia divina. Protegió a Jesús y a María en la tierra; desde el Cielo sigue protegiendo a la Iglesia y a nuestras familias.

Mientras continuamos nuestro camino cuaresmal, acudamos a él en los momentos de ansiedad y prueba. Que fortalezca nuestra confianza y nos proteja de todo mal.



La Liturgia de la Palabra: Dios habla a su pueblo

En la Liturgia de la Palabra, Dios se dirige a su pueblo a través de las palabras inspiradas de la Sagrada Escritura. Las lecturas siguen un leccionario cuidadosamente organizado que garantiza que los fieles escuchen una selección amplia y equilibrada de la Biblia a lo largo del tiempo. A través de estas lecturas, Cristo está verdaderamente presente, hablando a su Iglesia hoy.

Normalmente, la Liturgia de la Palabra incluye una lectura del Antiguo Testamento, un Salmo Responsorial, una lectura del Nuevo Testamento y el Evangelio. El Evangelio ocupa un lugar de especial reverencia porque proclama las palabras y acciones de Cristo mismo. La homilía ayuda a explicar y aplicar las lecturas, conectando la Palabra de Dios con nuestra vida diaria.

Nuestras respuestas —el Salmo, la Aclamación antes del Evangelio, la Profesión de Fe y la Oración de los Fieles— son expresiones esenciales de participación activa.

Al escuchar atentamente y responder con oración, permitimos que la Palabra de Dios moldee nuestra mente, profundice nuestra fe y nos llame a una conversión continua.




