Saints of the Week

Saint Fabian (d. 250 AD) was pope of the Catholic Church from 236 to 250 AD. According to early tradition, he was a layman visiting Rome when a dove unexpectedly landed on his head, a sign the faithful interpreted as God's choice for pope. Fabian proved to be a wise and capable leader, organizing the Church in Rome, strengthening its administration, and supporting missionary efforts in Gaul. His papacy ended during the persecution of Christians under the Roman Emperor Decius. Refusing to renounce his faith, Fabian was arrested and died as a martyr in 250 AD.

Saint Agnes (d. 304 AD) was a young Christian girl in Rome who lived in the early 4th century. Known for her purity and unwavering faith, she refused to renounce Christ or marry a pagan suitor. For her courage, she was condemned and suffered martyrdom while still very young. She is honored as a symbol of innocence, fidelity, and total devotion to God.

Saint Vincent (d. 304 AD) was a deacon from Spain who served under Bishop Valerius in the early 4th century. During the persecution of Emperor Diocletian, he was arrested for boldly professing the Christian faith. Despite severe torture, Vincent remained steadfast, eventually dying as a martyr. He is remembered for his courage, eloquence, and faithfulness.

Saint Francis de Sales (d. 1622 AD) lived in the late 16th and early 17th centuries and served as Bishop of Geneva. Known for his gentleness and wisdom, he worked tirelessly to bring people back to the Catholic faith through patience, kindness, and clear teaching. A prolific writer, he authored *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *Treatise on the Love of God*. He is honored as a Doctor of the Church.

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)

In our gospel we hear John the Baptist giving testimony about witnessing Jesus' baptism. John was clear that God's will for him was to point to Christ and proclaim that Jesus is the Son of God. Our faith and Sacred Scripture confirm the truth that Jesus is the Son of God. God's will for each one of us is to speak the name of Jesus and tell of His work in our lives. That is our calling and that is what being a disciple involves. Ask for the courage to see when and how you can testify – talk about - Jesus.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As the Christmas lights and decorations are packed away, I invite you to look back with gratitude at what we celebrated. Our Christmas celebrations once again reminded us of God's love, as Christ was born quietly in Bethlehem yet powerfully present in our lives, our families, and our parish community. I am deeply thankful for all who helped make the Christmas season prayerful and beautiful: our liturgical ministers, musicians, decorators, volunteers, and all who welcomed one another with generosity and faith.

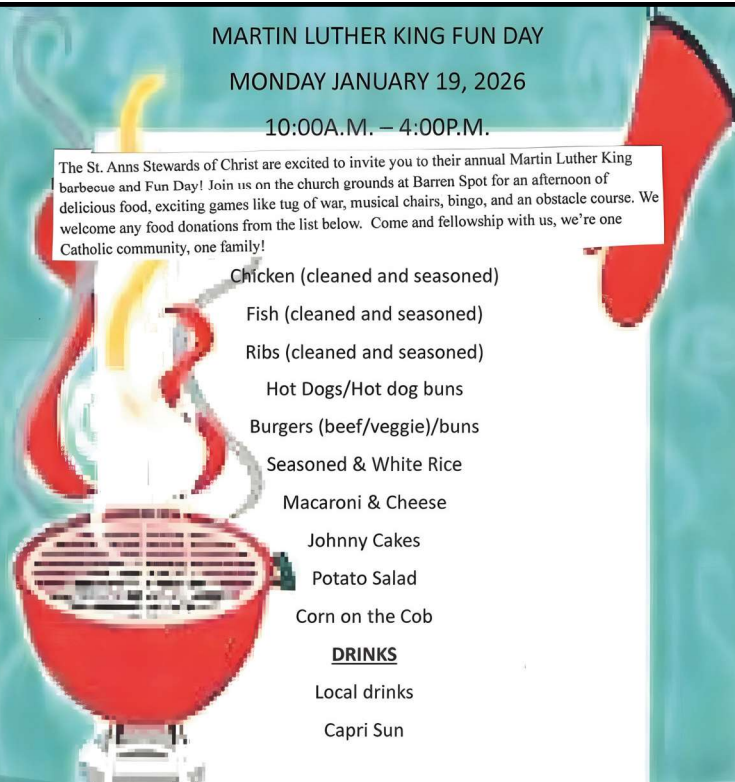

Liturgical Corner

The Paschal Mystery

The Paschal Mystery is the saving work of Jesus Christ through his Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension (glorification). It is the central mystery of the Christian faith because through these events God fulfilled his plan of salvation and redeemed humanity.

The Eucharist is directly and inseparably connected to the Paschal Mystery. At every Mass, the Church does not merely remember Christ's sacrifice; rather, through the power of the Holy Spirit, Christ's one sacrifice is made present. The Eucharist is the sacramental re-presentation of the Paschal Mystery—Christ's death and resurrection offered once for all, now made available to believers in every time and place.

In the Eucharist:

- Christ's sacrifice on the Cross is made present in an unbloody manner
- The Resurrection is proclaimed and celebrated
- The faithful are united to Christ's self-giving love

By receiving the Eucharist, Catholics participate in Christ's Paschal Mystery, sharing in his death to sin and his resurrection to new life. Thus, the Eucharist is both the memorial and the living presence of the Paschal Mystery and the source of Christian life and mission.

El Misterio Pascual

El Misterio Pascual es la obra salvífica de Jesucristo mediante su Pasión, Muerte, Resurrección y Ascensión (glorificación). Es el misterio central de la fe cristiana, ya que mediante estos acontecimientos Dios cumplió su plan de salvación y redimió a la humanidad.

La Eucaristía está directa e inseparablemente ligada al Misterio Pascual. En cada Misa, la Iglesia no solo recuerda el sacrificio de Cristo; más bien, mediante el poder del Espíritu Santo, el único sacrificio de Cristo se hace presente. La Eucaristía es la re-presentación sacramental del Misterio Pascual: la muerte y resurrección de Cristo ofrecidas una vez para siempre, ahora disponibles para los creyentes de todo tiempo y lugar. En la Eucaristía:

- El sacrificio de Cristo en la Cruz se hace presente de manera incruenta.
- La Resurrección se proclama y celebra.
- Los fieles se unen al amor oblativo de Cristo.

Al recibir la Eucaristía, los católicos participan en el Misterio Pascual de Cristo, compartiendo su muerte al pecado y su resurrección a una nueva vida. Así, la Eucaristía es a la vez memorial y presencia viva del Misterio Pascual, y fuente de la vida y la misión cristianas.

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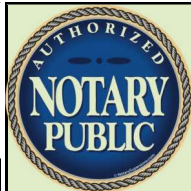
