FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

The theme of humility and divine rest flows through our readings this weekend. In our first reading, the prophet Zechariah speaks of a victorious savior who comes not with military might, but meekly riding on a donkey. In the Gospel, Jesus echoes this gentle spirit, offering us a profound invitation: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest."

When we attend Mass, do we bring our hidden exhaustion, our worries, and our heavy hearts to the altar? Are we willing to trade our self-reliance for the "light yoke" of Christ?

In a world that often demands constant productivity and self-promotion, Jesus models a radically different way of being—one rooted in humility and absolute trust in the Father. Let us surrender our burdens to the Lord and learn from His meek and humble heart.

The Saints of the Week

St. Maria Goretti (1890–1902) was an Italian peasant girl born in Corinaldo, Italy, known for her deep Catholic faith and devotion to purity. At age eleven, she was attacked by Alessandro Serenelli while resisting an attempted assault. She forgave him on her deathbed in 1902 after sustaining fatal injuries. Her forgiveness profoundly moved Serenelli, who later repented. She was canonized as a virgin martyr and is remembered as a model of mercy, purity, and courage for young Christians worldwide.

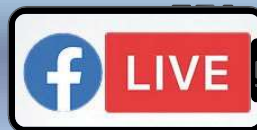
Saint Augustine Zhao Rong (1746–1815) was a Chinese soldier who converted to Catholicism after accompanying a missionary bishop during his imprisonment. He later became a priest and served the Church during a time of growing persecution in Qing dynasty China. During the anti-Christian persecutions, he was arrested for his faith and executed in 1815. He is honored as one of the Martyr Saints of China, canonized in 2000.

Saint Benedict of Nursia (c. 480–c. 547) was born in Italy and is regarded as the father of Western monasticism. He withdrew from society to live as a hermit, later gathering disciples and founding monastic communities at Subiaco and Monte Cassino. He wrote the Rule of Saint Benedict, emphasizing prayer, work, obedience, and community life. His Rule became the foundation of monastic life in Western Christianity and shaped medieval Europe spiritually and culturally. He is remembered for establishing a balanced path of discipline and devotion that influenced generations of monks today.

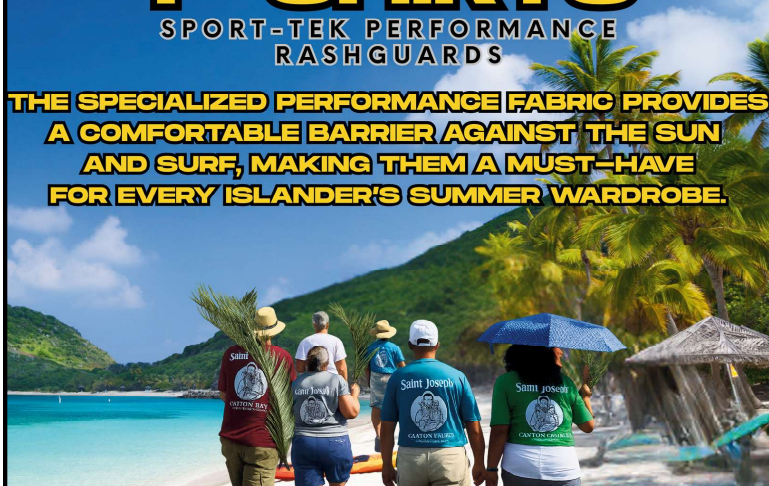

Liturgical Corner

Incense in the Liturgy

The use of incense in Christian liturgy is a profound tradition rooted in ancient worship, carrying rich biblical symbolism that bridges the earthly and the divine. Far from a mere decorative custom, incense serves as a sensory sermon, reminding believers that worship engages the entire person—body, mind, and spirit.

Scripturally, the sweet-smelling smoke is beautifully tied to prayer. As Psalm 141:2 states, "Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense," an image mirrored in Revelation 8:3–4, where the prayers of the saints rise to God from a golden altar. In liturgical celebrations, this rising smoke visually represents the community's intentions ascending to heaven.

Ultimately, incense transforms the physical environment. Its distinct fragrance and drifting mist signal that the mundane has given way to the holy, inviting the faithful to lift their hearts and enter the transcendent mystery of heavenly worship.

5 DE JULIO DECIMOCUARTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

El tema de la humildad y el descanso divino impregna nuestras lecturas de este fin de semana. En la primera lectura, el profeta Zacarías habla de un salvador victorioso que no viene con poderío militar, sino mansamente montado en un asno. En el Evangelio, Jesús se hace eco de este espíritu apacible, ofreciéndonos una profunda invitación: «Vengan a mí todos los que están cansados y agobiados, y yo les daré descanso».

Cuando asistimos a Misa, ¿llevamos al altar nuestro cansancio oculto, nuestras preocupaciones y nuestros corazones apesadumbrados? ¿Estamos dispuestos a cambiar nuestra autosuficiencia por el «yugo ligero» de Cristo?

En un mundo que a menudo exige productividad constante y autopromoción, Jesús nos muestra una forma de ser radicalmente diferente: una arraigada en la humildad y la confianza absoluta en el Padre. Entreguemos nuestras cargas al Señor y aprendamos de su corazón manso y humilde.

VIRGEN DEL CARMEN

La Virgen del Carmen es la Patrona del mar, de los marineros y de los pescadores de Vieques. Su fiesta se celebra cada 16 de julio.

Esta advocación mariana tiene sus orígenes en el Monte Carmelo, en Tierra Santa, donde desde tiempos antiguos vivieron ermitaños dedicados a la oración bajo la protección de la Santísima Virgen María. Con el paso de los siglos, la devoción a Nuestra Señora del Carmen se extendió por todo el mundo a través de la Orden Carmelita. y desde hace siglos los navegantes y pescadores la han venerado como su protectora y guía en el mar.

Con motivo de esta celebración, el domingo, 19 de julio, celebraremos la Fiesta de la Virgen del Carmen durante la Santa Misa de las 9:00 am.

Rincón Litúrgico

El incienso en la liturgia

El uso del incienso en la liturgia cristiana es una profunda tradición arraigada en el culto antiguo, la cual porta un rico simbolismo bíblico que une lo terrenal con lo divino. Lejos de ser una mera costumbre decorativa, el incienso sirve como un sermón sensorial que recuerda a los creyentes que la adoración involucra a toda la persona: cuerpo, mente y espíritu.

Estructuralmente, el humo aromático está bellamente ligado a la oración. Como afirma el Salmo 141:2: "Suba mi oración delante de ti como el incienso", una imagen reflejada en Apocalipsis 8:3-4, donde las oraciones de los santos se elevan ante Dios desde un altar de oro. En las celebraciones litúrgicas, este humo ascendente representa visualmente las intenciones de la comunidad que suben al cielo.

En última instancia, el incienso transforma el entorno físico. Su fragancia distintiva y su niebla flotante señalan que lo cotidiano ha dado paso a lo sagrado, invitando a los fieles a elevar sus corazones y adentrarse en el misterio trascendente del culto celestial.

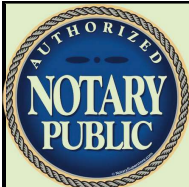
