

Saints of the Week

Saint Polycarp (c. 69 – c. 155 AD) was one of the Apostolic Fathers and served as Bishop of Smyrna. He is traditionally regarded as a disciple of Saint John the Apostle, linking him directly to the generation of the Apostles. Polycarp was a steadfast defender of orthodox Christian teaching against early heresies, particularly Gnosticism.

Polycarp is most famous for his martyrdom. During a persecution under Roman authorities, he was arrested and urged to renounce Christ. He refused, declaring that he had served Christ for eighty-six years and could not betray Him. He was sentenced to death and burned at the stake, though tradition holds that the flames did not harm him and he was ultimately killed by the sword. His martyrdom account is one of the earliest and most detailed records of a Christian martyr's death.

Saint Gregory of Narek (c. 951 – 1003 AD) was an Armenian monk, priest, poet, and mystic theologian. Born into a scholarly and ecclesiastical family, he entered the monastery of Narek on the shores of Lake Van, where he spent most of his life in prayer, study, and writing. Gregory is best known for his masterpiece, *The Book of Lamentations* (also called *Narek*), a profound collection of poetic prayers expressing deep repentance, humility, and longing for union with God. His writings had a lasting influence on Armenian spirituality and literature, and for centuries his *Book of Lamentations* has been cherished as a devotional and even healing text among Armenians. In 2015, Pope Francis declared him a Doctor of the Church, recognizing the universal theological and spiritual significance of his work.

FEBRUARY 22
FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT (A)

The first Sunday of Lent always begins with the reminder that Jesus was tempted, just as we are. Rather than giving in to the temptations, Jesus recognized that there could be no compromise in the message he needed to preach and in the faith he demanded. The readings on this first Sunday in Lent invite us to take time to look at our own lives and to consider the temptations we confront and that threaten to draw us away from God and from the light of Christ. Every prayer we offer, every fast we undertake, and every small sacrifice we make this Lent will lead us to the cross, the cross of victory over death. Spend time this Lent with Jesus, asking for help to overcome temptation and recognize the power of Jesus' resurrection.

Liturgical Corner

The Introductory Rites: Preparing to Worship

The Introductory Rites begin the Mass and serve to prepare the gathered assembly to enter into the sacred mysteries. These rites include the Entrance Chant, the Sign of the Cross, the Greeting, the Penitential Act, the Gloria on certain days, and the Collect. Together, they help unite the faithful and focus our hearts on worship.

The Entrance Chant and procession symbolize the Church on pilgrimage, coming together to meet the Lord. The Sign of the Cross reminds us that we gather in the name of the Trinity, and the Greeting makes visible the presence of Christ among His people. In the Penitential Act, we humbly acknowledge our sins and ask for God's mercy, recognizing our need for His grace.

The Gloria is a joyful hymn of praise that echoes the song of the angels at Christ's birth, while the Collect gathers the prayers and intentions of the entire assembly into one prayer offered by the priest.

Far from being routine or merely introductory, these rites help us transition from daily life into sacred time, preparing us to listen attentively and offer ourselves fully in worship.

Los Ritos Introdutorios: Preparación para el Culto

Los Ritos Introdutorios dan inicio a la Misa y preparan a la asamblea para entrar en los sagrados misterios. Estos ritos incluyen el Canto de Entrada, la Señal de la Cruz, el Saludo, el Acto Penitencial, el Gloria en ciertos días y la Colecta. Juntos, ayudan a unir a los fieles y a centrar nuestros corazones en la liturgia.

El Canto de Entrada y la procesión simbolizan a la Iglesia en peregrinación, uniéndose para encontrarse con el Señor. La Señal de la Cruz nos recuerda que nos reunimos en el nombre de la Trinidad, y el Saludo hace visible la presencia de Cristo entre su pueblo. En el Acto Penitencial, reconocemos humildemente nuestros pecados y pedimos la misericordia de Dios, reconociendo nuestra necesidad de su gracia.

El Gloria es un alegre himno de alabanza que evoca el canto de los ángeles en el nacimiento de Cristo, mientras que la Colecta reúne las oraciones e intenciones de toda la asamblea en una sola oración ofrecida por el sacerdote. Lejos de ser rutinarios o meramente introductorios, estos ritos nos ayudan a pasar de la vida cotidiana al tiempo sagrado, preparándonos para escuchar atentamente y ofrecernos plenamente en la adoración.




