



Saints of the Week

Saint Blaise (c. 280 AD - c. 316 AD) was a physician and later bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. He lived as a hermit for a time, known for his holiness and care for both people and animals. During Roman persecutions, he was arrested for his Christian faith and tortured. According to tradition, he miraculously healed a child choking on a fishbone, which is why he is invoked for throat ailments. He was ultimately martyred, likely by beheading, and is honored as one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers.

Saint Agatha (c. 231 AD - 251 AD) was a young Christian woman from Sicily who consecrated her life to God. During the persecution under Emperor Decius, she refused the advances of a Roman official and would not renounce her faith. She endured severe torture and died in prison. Saint Agatha is remembered for her courage, purity, and steadfast faith, and she is venerated as a martyr and patroness of those suffering from breast disease and natural disasters such as volcanic eruptions.

Saint Paul Miki and Companions (1562 - 1597) Saint Paul Miki was a Japanese Jesuit priest who preached Christianity during a time of growing hostility toward the faith in Japan. Along with 25 companions—religious and laypeople, including missionaries and Japanese converts—he was arrested and forced to march hundreds of miles as a public warning. They were crucified in Nagasaki in 1597. From the cross, Paul Miki preached forgiveness and faith in Christ. Together, they are honored as the Martyrs of Japan and witnesses to courageous Christian fidelity.

FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A)

This week, ask for the grace to be open to making the beatitudes the way you live your discipleship.



Liturgical Corner

What Is the Liturgy?

The word liturgy comes from a Greek term meaning “the work of the people,” but in the Church it has a much deeper and sacred meaning. The liturgy is the official public worship of the Church, in which Christ Himself acts through visible signs, sacred words, and ritual actions. It is not simply a community prayer service, nor is it a personal devotion shaped by individual preference. Rather, the liturgy is something we receive from the Church, faithfully handed down and carefully preserved, because its true author is Christ.

In the liturgy—especially in the celebration of the Mass—Christ continues His saving work. What He accomplished once and for all through His death and resurrection is made present sacramentally. We are not merely remembering past events; we are drawn into the living mystery of salvation. Christ is present in many ways: in the priest who presides, in the proclaimed Word, in the gathered assembly, and most fully in the Eucharist.

The liturgy also forms us as the Body of Christ. When Catholics around the world celebrate the same liturgy, using the same prayers and structure, we are visibly united across cultures and generations. By participating attentively, reverently, and prayerfully, the liturgy shapes our faith, teaches us how to pray, and sends us forth transformed to live what we celebrate.

¿Qué es la liturgia?

¿Qué es la Liturgia?

La palabra liturgia proviene de un término griego que significa "el trabajo del pueblo", pero en la Iglesia tiene un significado mucho más profundo y sagrado. La liturgia es el culto público oficial de la Iglesia, en el que Cristo mismo actúa mediante signos visibles, palabras sagradas y acciones rituales. No es simplemente un servicio de oración comunitario, ni una devoción personal moldeada por las preferencias individuales. Más bien, la liturgia es algo que recibimos de la Iglesia, transmitido fielmente y preservado cuidadosamente, porque su verdadero autor es Cristo.

En la liturgia, especialmente en la celebración de la Misa, Cristo continúa su obra salvadora. Lo que realizó de una vez por todas mediante su muerte y resurrección se hace presente sacramentalmente. No solo recordamos acontecimientos pasados; nos adentramos en el misterio vivo de la salvación. Cristo está presente de muchas maneras: en el sacerdote que preside, en la Palabra proclamada, en la asamblea reunida y, de forma más plena, en la Eucaristía.

La liturgia también nos forma como Cuerpo de Cristo. Cuando los católicos de todo el mundo celebran la misma liturgia, utilizando las mismas oraciones y la misma estructura, nos unimos visiblemente a través de culturas y generaciones. Al participar con atención, reverencia y oración, la liturgia moldea nuestra fe, nos enseña a orar y nos impulsa a vivir transformados lo que celebramos.


