# The Saints of the Week

**Saint Barnabas** (d. c. 61 AD) was one of the earliest followers of Jesus and a leading figure in the growth of the Christian Church. Born in Cyprus to a Jewish family, he sold his possessions to help the poor and dedicated his life to spreading the Gospel. He became a trusted companion of Saint Paul and traveled on missionary journeys preaching Christianity throughout the Roman world. Barnabas was admired for his generosity, faith, and ability to encourage others, earning him the title “Son of Encouragement.” His feast day is celebrated on June 11.

**The Sacred Heart of Jesus** devotion honors the heart of Christ as the symbol of His infinite love, mercy, and sacrifice for humanity. The feast is celebrated on the Friday after Corpus Christi and became widely known through the visions of Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647–1690) in France during the 17th century. The Sacred Heart reminds Christians of Jesus’ compassion, forgiveness, and desire for all people to live in His love and peace.

**Saint Anthony of Padua** (1195–1231) was born in Lisbon, Portugal, and later joined the Franciscan Order. He became one of the Church’s greatest preachers and teachers because of his deep knowledge of Scripture and powerful sermons. Known for his humility and care for the poor, he performed many miracles and is honored as the patron saint of lost items. His feast day is celebrated on June 13.

## JUNE 7 SOLEMNITY OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST ~ CORPUS CHRISTI

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Our readings today give us “food for thought” to savor and ponder, especially these words from the gospel, “Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life.” It is important for us to look beyond the physical to a deeper meaning, to see that Jesus gives himself as a sustaining presence of our spiritual life. When we receive communion, we commit ourselves to embody Christ by living in the Spirit. As we leave Mass today, let us strive to be life-giving bread in some small ways that witness to Christ’s love and presence.

**On June 11, 2026, the bishops of the United States will consecrate our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, celebrating the 250th anniversary of the Declaration of Independence.**

# 8<sup>TH</sup> From the Pastor's Pen

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Every Sunday when we gather for Mass, we aren't just stepping into a building—we are stepping into a sacred mystery. Lately, many have been using the side doors for convenience, but our church's main entrance holds a deeply profound purpose for both our arrival and our departure.

I invite you to reclaim the use of the main doors for these beautiful reasons:

- **We are pilgrims:** The word parishioner means "pilgrim." When you enter the main doors, you look down the main aisle toward the altar, a visual reminder that our earthly life is a journey toward God.
- **We are sent after Mass:** Just as the aisle leads us to the altar, it also leads us back out. At the end of Mass, as we walk down the main aisle from the altar to the main doors, we are being sent forth. The final blessing sends us out as missionaries into the world. Leaving through the side doors disrupts this powerful symbol of being sent from the altar out into the world.
- **Christ is the Door:** Jesus said, "I am the door" (John 10:9). Crossing the main threshold is a liturgical act. It symbolizes leaving the world behind to enter the kingdom of God together, and then returning to the world renewed.
- **Our Weekly Connection:** On a personal note, the main doors are where I stand to greet you. Sunday is often the only time we see each other all week. When you use the side doors, I miss the chance to look you in the eye, welcome you, or wish you a blessed week.

Next Sunday, please take an extra minute to enter and exit through the front doors. Let's reclaim the beauty of entering God's house together, being sent forth on mission, and sharing a smile.

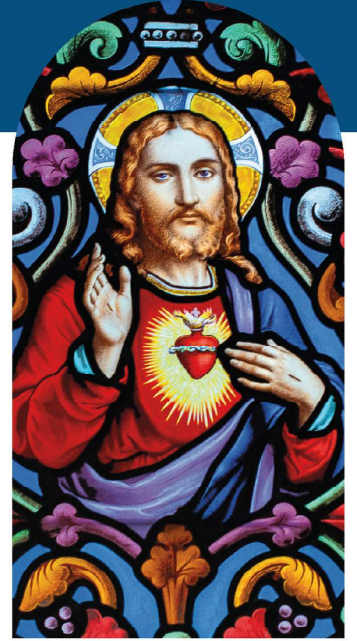

## Liturgical Corner

### The Sign of Peace

The Sign of Peace is a profound liturgical action that expresses our deep unity in Christ before we receive the Holy Eucharist. It serves as a visible, physical gesture of reconciliation, sharply reminding us that vertical communion with God is inherently linked to our horizontal communion with one another. We cannot fully receive Christ if we are divided from our neighbor; thus, this moment echoes Jesus' command to leave our gift at the altar and first be reconciled with our brother. This exchange is meant to be simple and reverent, not social or distracting. It prepares our hearts to approach the altar worthily, committed to peace and charity. By offering peace to one another, we acknowledge that the Eucharist strengthens us to become instruments of Christ's peace in the world.

# Desde la pluma del parroco

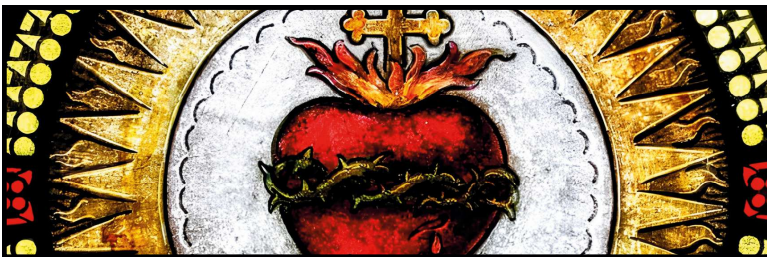
Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Cada domingo, al reunirnos para la Misa, no solo entramos en un edificio, sino en un misterio sagrado. Ultimamente, muchos usan las puertas laterales por comodidad, pero la entrada principal de nuestra iglesia tiene un significado profundo tanto para nuestra llegada como para nuestra salida. Los invito a recuperar el uso de las puertas principales por estas hermosas razones:

- **Somos peregrinos:** La palabra feligrés significa "peregrino". Al entrar por las puertas principales, se mira hacia el altar, un recordatorio visual de que nuestra vida terrenal es un viaje hacia Dios.
- **Somos enviados:** Así como el pasillo nos lleva al altar, también nos lleva de regreso. Al final de la Misa, al caminar por el pasillo principal desde el altar hasta las puertas principales, somos enviados. La bendición final nos envía como misioneros al mundo. Salir por las puertas laterales interrumpe este poderoso símbolo de ser enviados desde el altar al mundo.
- **Cristo es la Puerta:** Jesús dijo: «Yo soy la puerta» (Juan 10:9). Cruzar el umbral principal es un acto litúrgico. Simboliza dejar atrás el mundo para entrar juntos al reino de Dios y luego regresar al mundo renovados.
- **Nuestra Conexión Semanal:** Personalmente, las puertas principales son donde los saludo. El domingo suele ser el único día que nos vemos en toda la semana. Cuando usan las puertas laterales, pierdo la oportunidad de mirarlos a los ojos, darles la bienvenida o desearles una semana bendecida.

El próximo domingo, por favor, tómense un minuto más para entrar y salir por las puertas principales. Recuperemos la belleza de entrar juntos a la casa de Dios, ser enviados en misión y compartir una sonrisa.

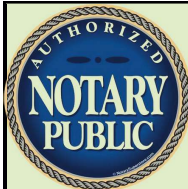
