The Saints of the Week

Saint Anselm (1033–1109) Anselm was a Benedictine monk, philosopher, and Archbishop of Canterbury known for his intellectual approach to faith. He formulated the famous ontological argument for God’s existence and emphasized “faith seeking understanding.” A defender of Church independence, he clashed with English kings over authority but remained steadfast in his theological and moral convictions.

Saint George (c. 280–303) was a Roman soldier who became a Christian martyr under Emperor Diocletian. Revered for his courage and faith, he is best known through the story of slaying a dragon, symbolizing the triumph of good over evil. He is venerated as a patron saint of soldiers and several nations, including England.

Saint Fidelis of Sigmaringen (1577–1622) was born Mark Roy. He was a lawyer who became a Capuchin friar devoted to preaching and reform during the Counter-Reformation. He traveled through Switzerland converting many to Catholicism. His mission ended in martyrdom when he was killed by a hostile crowd, remaining faithful to his beliefs until death.

Saint Mark the Evangelist (c. 5–68 AD) traditionally identified as the author of the second Gospel, was a companion of apostles Peter and Paul. His Gospel emphasizes Christ’s actions and suffering. He is believed to have founded the Church in Alexandria and died as a martyr, becoming one of Christianity’s four Evangelists.

APRIL 19 THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

In the gospel we meet two disciples on the road to Emmaus, a road that led out of Jerusalem, away from the place of Jesus' death. Their discouragement at his death led them want to walk away. But Jesus meets them where they were, listens to them and opens their minds and hearts. Then he did something familiar - “he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them” In that simple act their eyes were opened. They recognized him. This encounter with Christ changed them forever. Jesus is with us at every Mass in the scripture we hear, in the breaking of the bread – in the Eucharist. Do we recognize him and know his presence? Like those early disciples, after receiving Christ in the Eucharist do we say, ‘Were not our hearts burning within us...?’ Let us pray that our hearts will “burn within us” each time we receive Jesus in Holy Communion.

Liturgical Corner

Sacred Gestures: Bows, Genuflection, and the Sign of the Cross

Gestures play an important role in the liturgy, expressing reverence and belief through simple bodily actions. These gestures are not empty habits; they are acts of faith that help us acknowledge God's presence and respond appropriately.

Bowing is a sign of respect and humility, often made at the mention of the Trinity or when approaching the altar. Genuflection—bending the knee toward the tabernacle—is a profound gesture of adoration reserved for Christ present in the Eucharist. Through this action, we proclaim our belief in the Real Presence.

The Sign of the Cross, made frequently during Mass, summarizes our faith in the Trinity and in Christ's saving sacrifice. When performed deliberately and reverently, these gestures deepen our participation in the liturgy. They remind us that worship involves our whole person—body, mind, and soul—offered to God in love and devotion.

Gestos Sagrados: Inclinationes, Genuflexión y la Señal de la Cruz

Los gestos desempeñan un papel importante en la liturgia, ya que expresan reverencia y fe a través de acciones corporales sencillas. Estos gestos no son hábitos vacíos; son actos de fe que nos ayudan a reconocer la presencia de Dios y a responder adecuadamente.

La inclinación es un signo de respeto y humildad, que a menudo se realiza al mencionar a la Trinidad o al acercarse al altar. La genuflexión —doblar la rodilla ante el sagrario— es un gesto profundo de adoración reservado para Cristo presente en la Eucaristía. Mediante esta acción, proclamamos nuestra fe en la Presencia Real.

La Señal de la Cruz, que se hace con frecuencia durante la Misa, resume nuestra fe en la Trinidad y en el sacrificio salvador de Cristo. Cuando se realiza de manera consciente y reverente, estos gestos profundizan nuestra participación en la liturgia. Nos recuerdan que la adoración involucra a toda nuestra persona —cuerpo, mente y alma— ofrecida a Dios con amor y devoción.

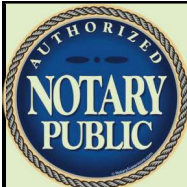
